



A Caregiver is: A relative or friend who is age 18 or older and who is actively caring for a person age 18 and older who has a functional disability. The caregiver does this without financial compensation (unpaid). And the care receiver is not receiving Medicaid-funded longer term care services.

The Family Caregiver Program helps unpaid family caregivers continue at-home care to the care recipients. We have certified Caregiver Specialists available who help you access supportive services and work with you to better manage your caregiver experience and journey.
